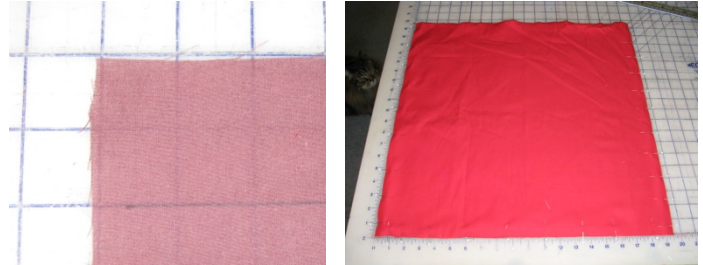


Supplies: 2 x 19 1/2" squares of fabric, 1.1m webbing, thread
 1/2" seam allowances unless otherwise mentioned

Bag Assembly

1. On the right side, with fabric pen and ruler, make a line
 2" from the top of each square (hem line)



2. Place squares right sides together, and pin the three
 unmarked edges. Sew seam, backstitching at beginning and end and pivoting in corners. Edge finish seam by sewing
 with three step zigzag.

Bottom

3. Pinch corners together to create a triangle, lining up
 seams. Pin 3 1/2" from point, perpendicular to seam.



4. With fabric pen and ruler, make a line continuing pinned
 seam line to fabric edge. Stitch seam.



Hem and Straps

5. Press hem toward wrong side on marked hem line.

6. Fold raw edge into hem (1" double hem). Press. Pin.

7. Cut webbing in half. Turn bag inside out and measure
 5 1/2" from each side seam, mark. Working one side at a time, place
 strap to inside of either mark, with webbing at bottom edge of hem,
 ensuring strap is not twisted. Pin.



8. Sew 7/8" hem catching straps. Re-pin straps so they don't twist. Stitch hem again close to edge. With fabric pen,
 create stitching lines for strap ends. Stitch.

Finishing

9. Mark hem 3 1/4" from
 each side seam. Pinch at
 marks and pin. Edge
 stitch within seam lines.



Press and enjoy your new bag! Great for groceries ... or cats!
